#### What?

ETF All-Stars Thematic Indexes are the first ever suite of indexes harnessing the growth and transparency of thematic ETFs to establish a consensus view on which companies best align with popular investment themes based on publicly available ETF ownership data.

#### How?

Using ETF Action's proprietary classification system and ownership database, ETF holdings data is aggregated across each broad thematic segment to determine each companies' ownership adjusted market value ("OAMV $^{\text{TM}}$ "). OAMV $^{\text{TM}}$  is calculated by taking the total ownership value of each company in an ETF segment (qualifying ETFs are subject to a 10% influence cap) times the number of ETFs that own each company in the targeted segment. Each index represents 75% of the OAMV $^{\text{TM}}$ for each ETF segment. Qualifying companies are weighted by OAMV $^{\text{TM}}$ , subject to a 5% weighting cap. The indexes are then rebalaned monthly.


